Reach for Resources is looking for a full-time Parenting Skills Educator to work with parents in the Family & Parenting Development program. Educators will work with parents with active Child Protection cases to provide in-home parenting education as well as guided and directed parent-child interaction sessions and observations. Skills taught to parents include those around child development, child/family safety, domestic violence, substance use, and positive discipline techniques. Services may be provided virtually and/or in person, based on parent/guardian preference. Services primarily provided during daytime hours with occasional evenings and weekends based on parent/guardian need. FPD services are intended to improve the well-being of children and families by strengthening parenting abilities, reducing reports of abuse and neglect, and preventing out-of-home placements.
