So far, he has participated in: downhill skiing, cross country skiing, snowboarding, rock climbing, spin class, full body conditioning and cycling. Of all the activities Tay participates in, snowboarding is his favorite. For four years, Tay has been challenging his vision, particularly night vision, through snowboarding. The snowboarding program is held at night and Tay is completely night blind. Riding with two guides, Tay says each year he enjoys training them on blind riders.

## Director of Community Living Joins MN Task Force

Congratulations to our Director of Community Living, Larissa Beck, for being selected as 1 of 19 individuals to be part of the MN Department of Human Services Task Force on Eliminating Subminimum Wages. Larissa was appointed by ARRM to be their representative.

What is the Task Force on Eliminating Subminimum Wages? The Minnesota legislature passed language to establish a task force that would develop a plan and make recommendations on how to phase-out subminimum wages for people who have disabilities. The recommendations will help make sure these individuals are not left without day services and employment options. The work done by the task force does not include the authority to end the use of subminimum wage in Minnesota. To eliminate subminimum wages, that would require separate legislation.

## Adaptive Recreation & Inclusion Program Policies

I understand that participation in this activity is completely voluntary and the activity is being offered for the benefit of the participant. Reach for Resources, Inc. along with its agents and employees shall not be liable for any claims, injuries, or damages of whatever nature, incurred by the participant arising out of, or connected with, recreational activities. All participants must be registered for a program in order to attend. Please register at least two weeks prior to the beginning of a program. If there are not enough people registered for a program it will be canceled a minimum of 3 days prior to the beginning of the program. Participants will be notified by phone or email and a refund will be processed. If classes or recreation activities are canceled due to inclement weather, Reach will schedule a make-up session or offer a refund when possible. For a recorded message about activity cancellations, call 952-200-3030. A written request to withdraw from an activity at least two weeks prior to the activity is eligible to receive a refund (except for Weekend Ventures, which abides by a separate cancellation policy), less a \$5 cancellation fee per class. Refunds are not awarded for ticketed events. Caregivers are welcome to attend all Reach programming with the exception of On The Town. Support staff and family can attend most activities free of charge, but are required to pay for ticketed events that they wish to attend. Caregivers are asked to provide any individualized support that the person they are supporting may need. Reach cannot be responsible for participants who arrive early or depart late from the scheduled program times. If a participant is more than 5 minutes late at a community-based event, staff may no longer be waiting for their arrival. If a participant is not picked up immediately after the end of a program, a \$10 fee will be billed for every 15 minutes after the scheduled program ending time. Participants in art and cooking classes should dress in old clothing and/or bring a paint shirt or apron. Reach will not be responsible for clothing that is damaged. Prescription and non-prescription drugs are the sole responsibility of the participant.
