Who is Reach for Resources?

Reach is a nonprofit organization who serves and empowers people of all-abilities throughout the Twin Cities metro and surrounding suburbs. We provide individualized services that maximize independence, boosts community engagement and improves physical and emotional well-being.

What services does Reach provide?

Reach provides five main services: Adaptive Recreation & Inclusion, Mental Health, Counseling, Community Living and Case Management. Adaptive Recreation & Inclusion offers a variety of activity programs that are specifically designed to meet the needs of people with disabilities. Community Living provides employment support, housing stabilization and living support services. Mental Health offers a variety of specialized services to address both disability concerns and mental health conditions. Case Management provides personalized supports to individuals looking to coordinate their services through waiver funding. Counseling offers individual and group therapy.
