Brian's Journey to Owning a Home

Over the past 6 years, Brian has undergone some exciting life changes, from renting his first apartment to purchasing his own home. How did he accomplish these big life changes? After Brian graduated from Vector with a degree in computers, he independently secured a job at a local computer business. At this point, his parents sought additional resources to help their son fully integrate into his community and become self-sufficient. Upon hearing about Reach for Resources from a friend, Brian's mom contacted our Director of Community Living to inquire about our in-home services. Our in-home services help adults with developmental disabilities integrate into their communities while achieving the highest level of self-reliance possible.

In 2018, Brian began working with Thuy, one of our Community Living Specialists. Thuy and Brian met weekly to develop and work on various independent living skills like cooking and cleaning. This eventually led to Brian acquiring his first apartment and living on his own. Throughout this transition, Thuy supported him every step of the way. As Brian settled into his apartment, they continued their weekly meetings to practice cooking, trying new recipes, tackling apartment maintenance, and addressing any issues that arose. Even through Covid, Thuy and Brian persisted, meeting virtually until it was safe to meet in-person outdoors. At Brian's apartment, they would grill in the courtyard, where Brian perfected his grilling skills, particularly hamburgers—now a signature dish his dad loves! Around this time, Brian also joined one of Reach's non-competitive bowling leagues, that meets every Saturday. Living independently, attending a weekly bowling league, and maintaining the same job for over 20 years, Brian was starting to come into his own.

As rent prices continued to rise, Brian's brother suggested he purchase a home, with mortgage payments being comparable to rent. Armed with a budget, Brian began house hunting. In a seller's market, it took him a few months to find the perfect home. In August 2023, Brian officially moved into his newly purchased house. Continuing to live independently, Brian met weekly with Thuy to navigate the responsibilities of homeownership. Thuy supported him through major home improvements, such as replacing gutters and resolving sewer issues, with his brother's help. Brian loves his new home because he “always has a parking spot, and it's quiet—no one doing the Cha-Cha a floor above him at all hours of the day.” Plus, he enjoys cooking his favorite meals like shepherd's pie, tater tot hotdish, and chicken teriyaki with rice. Brian has also expanded his culinary skills to include baking, particularly pies and cakes, earning him a reputation among family, friends, and co-workers for his delicious pressure cooker cake made with just cake mix and soda.

Looking ahead, Brian plans to make additional renovations to his home, including updating his kitchen cabinets with assistance from his brother, who's an architect. Additionally, Brian is excited to start grilling, to keep rolling strikes at Reach's weekly bowling league, and to continue working at his current job, where he reached the 25-year milestone this year.

Over the past 6 years, Brian has encountered ups and downs, but with Reach's in-home services and Thuy's support, he has flourished. Brian's dad remarked, “Thuy has gotten Brian through some challenging times and advocated for him. There was a very serious situation with the police that wasn't Brian's fault. Thuy advocated for Brian and explained to the police that Brian couldn't have done what they said he did. We are so thankful for that. Thuy has taught Brian many practical skills. He pays more attention to her, someone outside of his parents.” Brian's dad continued, “Thuy has helped Brian become more self-sufficient with cooking and recipes. My wife and I have seen Brian blossom a lot since Thuy has been working with him.”

Brian advice for anyone considering Reach, “Yes, join Reach because they have a lot of resources to help people be independent. Thuy has been a major help in my life. I don't think I would have been able to get an apartment or help with other stuff without Thuy.” We are excited to witness Brian's continued growth and independence in his community and first home.

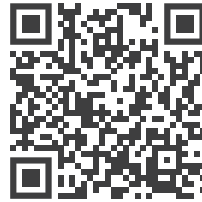


TRAIL by Reach expands to St. Louis Park

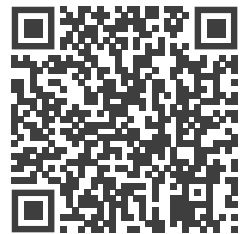

PROGRAM POLICIES & PROCEDURES

REGISTRATION

- All participants must be registered for a program to attend. Friends, housemates, etc. cannot attend with a registered participant without obtaining special permission from the Reach Recreation Department. If the activities are held at a community center, there are often common spaces where others can wait.
- Registrations are accepted online, in person, or by mail. Registrations are not taken at programs or over the phone.
- Register at least two weeks before the beginning of a program. Some programs do fill up, and you may be placed on a waiting list if the program is full.
- If you register for a recurring program after it has started, Reach will welcome you to join and prorate the registration fee as long as there is space in the program.
- Online registration closes three days before each program.

REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION

- Registration confirmations will be sent to the email used during registration or the email provided on the email form.

PAYMENT METHODS

- Reach accepts all major credit cards, cash, checks and money orders.
- CDCS waivers can be billed with guardian approval and proper paperwork.
- Traditional waivers are only accepted for ILS therapy programs (Art Therapy and Rec Therapy).

PROGRAM & CLASS CANCELLATIONS

- While rare, Reach reserves the right to cancel a program due to circumstances beyond our control including severe weather or due to a lack of staff and/or participants.

PROGRAM WITHDRAWAL

- Participants who call or email to withdraw from an activity at least two weeks before the activity are eligible to receive a refund. A \$5 cancellation fee will be charged per class. Refunds are not awarded with less than 2 weeks' notice or for ticketed events.
- There are no refunds for a missed program or class.
- ILS therapy classes abide by a separate cancellation policy.

STAFF RATIOS / SUPPORT STAFF / CAREGIVERS

- Caregivers, family & support staff can attend any programs except for Independent Adult Programs.
- Staff ratios are different for each program. If a participant requires more assistance than a program offers, please provide that support by sending along a caregiver.
- Reach staff is unable to spend a lot of 1:1 time with participants. Individuals who need 1:1 support should always have support staff with them at programs.

ARRIVING EARLY OR LATE

- Reach cannot be responsible for participants who arrive early or depart late from the scheduled program times. All participants who arrive early to a program must wait in the lobby or near the front entrance until the scheduled program time.

LATE PICKUP FEE

- If a participant is not picked up immediately after the end of a program, a \$10 fee will be billed for every 15 minutes after the scheduled program ending time.

ATTIRE

- Participants in art and cooking classes should dress in old clothing and/or bring a paint shirt or apron. Reach will not be responsible for clothing that is damaged.

MEDICATIONS

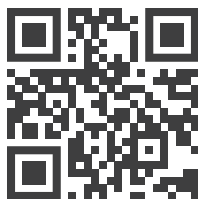
- Medications, prescription, and non-prescription drugs are the sole responsibility of the participant. At no time can a Reach staff assume responsibility for or administer medications in any form.
- Reach staff can assist with lifesaving procedures (ex: EpiPen®) as long as staff are made aware of the potential need for this procedure & provided with the necessary supplies.

ILLNESS / INJURY

- If a participant becomes ill or injured, staff will contact the emergency contact immediately. If the emergency contact can't be reached, staff will contact medical personnel.

INFECTION CONTROL

- To minimize exposure to other participants and staff, participants are requested to stay home if they have the following symptoms/diagnoses:
- Covid-19. If you are diagnosed with Covid-19 or suspect you may have Covid-19 please follow CDC guidelines for quarantine and isolation.
- An upper respiratory infection such as bronchiolitis or influenza.
- Fever of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or over within the past 24 hours. Individuals must be fever-free WITHOUT the use of Tylenol or other fever-reducers for at least 24 hours.
- Vomiting or diarrhea within the past 24 hours.
- Head lice or pink-eye (must be on eye-drops for at least 24 hours before attending).
- Strep-throat or any other illness that requires antibiotics. Individuals must be on antibiotics for at least 24 hours before attending a program.

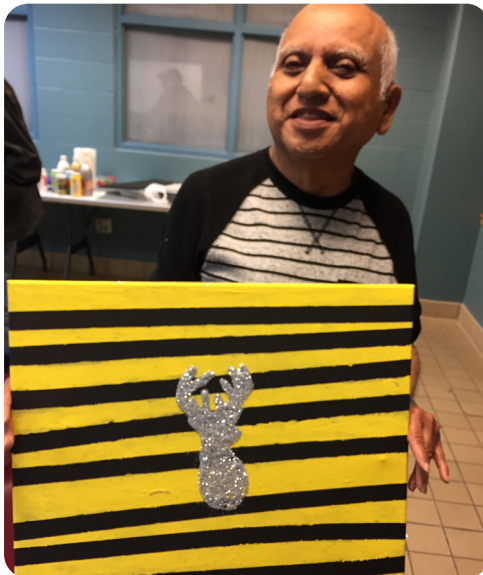

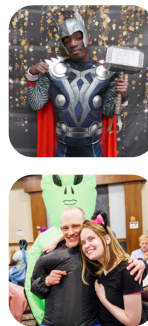
