In this role, you will provide one-on-one paraprofessional assistance to children of all abilities attending outdoor recreation camps. You will play a crucial role in ensuring that every child has a safe, enjoyable, and inclusive experience in the outdoors.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide one-on-one support to children with varying abilities (intellectual and/or physical) during outdoor recreation activities and camps.

- Participate actively in outdoor activities such as paddling watercraft, biking, hiking, working with animals, and other recreational activities.
- Adapt activities and instructions to accommodate the diverse needs and abilities of participants, promoting an
 inclusive and supportive environment for all.
- Collaborate with program leaders and fellow staff members to plan and implement engaging and accessible outdoor recreation programs.
- Maintain a positive and encouraging attitude while fostering a sense of belonging and empowerment among participants.
- Assist with program logistics, equipment setup, and maintenance to ensure smooth operation of outdoor recreation activities.
- Travel to and work at multiple Three Rivers Parks locations across the Twin Cities metro area as needed.
- Complete inclusion paperwork.
